## Board of Discipleship Ministry June/July Update

The Board of Discipleship Ministry (BDM) reviewed the plans of the Procurement Team to manage the bid process for the roof replacement, air conditioner removal and relocation. It has been determined from samples of the Narthex ceiling that there is a level of asbestos that will have to be removed. This team will manage this bid process as well.

The BDM Governance Policy Manual has been formally accepted and plans to initiate implementation of the manual will be the next step for the BDM in this effort. The BDM would like to express our thanks and appreciation to Jeff Edge and his committee for their outstanding work on the Governance Policy Manual. The review and approval of the PLC Personnel Policy has been completed by the BDM. The final copy will be in the Church Office after all corrections have been made.

There is ongoing discussion on PLC's election process. There are three outstanding issues encountered from the last election that need clarification before notification to the congregation. After additional discussion, a subcommittee was appointed by President Blue to develop criteria for candidates as a part of the 2010 election process.

An update on our 50th anniversary plans was presented to the BDM. It was agreed that the BDM would place a full page ad in the souvenir booklet. We encourage all members of the PLC family to take this opportunity to be a part of our history by placing an ad in the program booklet and to support the activities and events in our year of Jubilee.

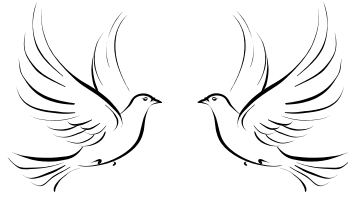

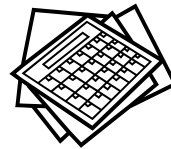
