Church, about two weeks before Elder Leacraft passed, I had made contacts with Adrienne Reeder from the Zealia Centre and Mrs. Tynes at Hughes Memorial to discuss with them the possibility of using their facilities for a repast if we had a need. I also talked with Pastor Lloyd Gaines, Mission & Ministry Facilitator for the Northern Area of the Southeastern District, for suggestions on securing pastors for a funeral. We serve a good God! Before

Temporarily, the church will pay the cost for the rental of Hughes Memorial or the Zealia Centre for a repast for members of Peace. Both places have agreed to let us rent the facility for \$225. It will be more for Hughes Memorial if a Saturday date is chosen. The church will also provide the food for a member. Because we are not using our Fellowship Hall for these kinds of events, the maximum amount the church will pay for a funeral conducted at Peace, will be \$500 for a member. This is a temporary increase of \$100 until the Fellowship Hall is restored.

In this Easter Season our hopes are renewed in all God has ahead for us. We were blessed eternally when Christ rose from the dead. The Easter Story is one we can take to heart and one we can decide to live for ourselves. God's continued Blessing during this Easter Season.

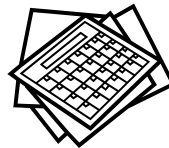
